Welcome to Nuweiba, South Sinai – A Valley of Hope!

The *LAB '26* is an invitation into a living field of regeneration: of land, of livelihoods, of relationships, of imagination, and of hope.

In and around **Habiba Community**, a growing group of local people, farmers, entrepreneurs, educators, hosts, change-makers and international friends is shaping practical pathways for the future of South Sinai — **one farm at a time, one project at a time, one meaningful connection at a time.**

The *LAB '26* is for people who do not only want to talk about climate change, ecosystem regeneration, regional resilience and better futures — but who want to **feel, learn, contribute and co-create** in a real place, with real people, and with real initiatives already underway.

The *LAB '26* is not a conference. It is not a retreat in the usual sense either. It is a **6-day immersive field experience** at the intersection of:

- **ecosystem regeneration**
- **green SME growth**
- **edutourism**
- **community life**
- **personal and societal transformation**

It is an invitation to step into a place where hope is not an abstract idea, but something people are working on with their hands, their hearts, their relationships and their courage.



The *LAB '26* inquires three sources of hope

1. Ecosystem Regeneration — one farm at a time

What is already here is a living foundation: a growing network of local farms, thousands of trees & plants planted under arid conditions, and active connections with the Ecosystem Restoration Communities, the Global Ecovillage Network, the SHAGRA Charity and several universities — a strong basis for further research, development and regenerative cooperation. Our burning future question: **How can degraded land, scarce water, local knowledge, entrepreneurship, education and international cooperation come together in new ways for regenerative work?**

2. Green SME Growth – feeling the heartbeat of the South Sinai economy

The *LAB '26* opens a space to experience and support local entrepreneurship, emerging projects and purpose-driven economic activity in the region. Our burning future question: **How can we grow more enterprises that are rooted here, creative, resilient and life-serving?**

3. Edutourism - learning how to regenerate hope

There is a growing need for places where people can learn from living examples — not from theory alone. Habiba Community is such a place: a place of encounter, learning, inspiration and participation. Our burning future question:

How can we further develop learning journeys & transformative travel and make the Environmental Institute an international lighthouse for innovative research & solutions?

Who is this for? We are especially inviting three groups of people:

People seeking personal and societal transformation

Especially people from Western contexts who feel the urgency of climate change, ecosystem breakdown and social fragmentation — and who are looking for places where inner work and outer change can genuinely meet.

This may be for you if you are asking:

- Where are the real places of hope?
- How can I contribute meaningfully?
- What does regeneration feel like in practice?
- How can I reconnect purpose, relationship and action?

Professionals in environmental & related fields

From both the **scientific** and the **business** community, for example:

- researchers
- environmental practitioners
- entrepreneurs & investors
- ecosystem regeneration professionals
- educators
- regional development actors

This may be for you if you want to connect your expertise with:

- local initiatives & practical field realities
- meaningful cross-sector exchange
- possible future cooperation

Community lovers & families

People who long for places of meaning, simplicity and shared purpose.

This may be for you if you want to:

- experience a living community field
- expose your children to a more hopeful future narrative
- combine meaningful travel with learning and connection
- explore how family life and regenerative culture can belong together

For this year we are planning a **family-friendly format**, in which one parent may participate in the main Lab while the other joins a parallel **Junior Lab** experience with the young ones.



What kind of experience is this?

The *LAB '26* is a **facilitated and co-created experience**. Over six days, we will bring together local reality and international perspective, field visits and dialogue, deep insights and relationship-building, community life and reflective space.

There will be space for:

- deepening one's own sense of purpose and contribution
- seeing and sensing what is already alive
- understanding key local initiatives and their context
- identifying meaningful points of connection
- exploring new ideas and practical next steps
- sharing meals, stories, beauty, humour and surprises...

The *LAB '26* is not random. It draws on a facilitation approach that supports coherence between inner calling, outer reality and shared action. **Methods from Emotional Innovation Solutions™** such as **Open Space Technology & Systemic Innovation Constellations (SynC™)** will be part of the process — always in service of lively research on our guiding questions, connection and next meaningful steps.

How can you become a part of the journey?

Participation: We are currently looking for 11 paying participants for the October 2026 Lab. Places are intentionally limited to 20 in total, so that the experience can remain personal, connected and impactful.
